


Resize an Image using Microsoft Office (MS) Paint


Microsoft includes MS Paint free with Windows 10.

MS Paint can size images, specifically the image dimensions. This image editor works well for resizing photos and graphics to be used for online applications like websites and social media.

1. Open the Paint app first on your Windows PC, and then; you click file > open.




2. Navigate to the Home tab. You will find an option called Resize.




3. There are two options to change the photos size: percentage or pixels. Either option will work depending on the goal.

- Pixels are recommended for accurate resizing
- Percentage is good for broad resizing



4. After selection, click OK.

5. When you are done, click File > Save As
